Parental/Guardian Consent is required for Children under the age of 18yrs before participation in RYT activities

RYT does not accept liability for any injury, loss or damage sustained during the course of; or associated with any RYT classes or activities.

In the event of a serious injury or medical crisis, RYT will call an ambulance to take the participant to hospital. The cost of the ambulance and any medical treatment required will be paid for by the participant.

I give my permission (as parent/caregiver) for this participant to be photographed or recorded on video by RYT staff for promotional and archival purposes.

Photography and video recordings are not allowed during workshops or events by parents and others unless pre-arranged with RYT.

Stretchy comfortable clothes (track pants, shorts, leggings) We often take off shoes when in the workshops, however, footwear is required when outside and when going to the toilet. For Participants, Parents, Guardians and Visitors at RYT

All participants under the age of 16 must be dropped off and collected by a parent or guardian (unless arranged prior to the workshop).

Parents and children not participating in class are not permitted in the training space without permission from a trainer or staff member.

If the participant is sick with an infectious disease, or any injury or medical condition that might put them or others at risk of illness or injury, please contact RYT and do not come to the session.

RYT respects the rights, dignity and worth of others regardless of age, gender and sexuality, physical or mental ability, cultural background or religion, and expects that participants and those observing classes follow this code of conduct.

Disruptive, rude, and inappropriate behaviour is not conducive to a positive environment and will not be tolerated, and participants will be asked to take time out from the session.
