It feels great to be writing a program welcome for the second time! I know so much more about our community and its needs than I did a year ago. So welcome! Welcome to a big, bold, colourful 2023.

In 2022, our team grew. The addition of four new roles has restructured our company, diversified our offerings and placed our core values front and centre.

Our Community and Digital Artist (a position funded by Variety SA), Alysha, runs a robust digital program as well as *Home Turf*, a school holiday program offered in Pinnaroo, Lameroo, Blanchetown and Morgan – towns often left out of creative programs. At the heart of Alysha's role is RYT's commitment to creating pathways for young regional people to find Their People and their passions.

1-2-1 Coordinator/Games Master, Jay, has brought to the fore our passion for one-on-one work to support children with complex social needs. We know that 'family friendly' does not necessarily mean 'friendly for all families'. With this role, we are working to make RYT a radically accessible safe space for neurodiverse children, those living with disabilities and carers. Tech Wizard/Take It Apart Club Captain, Melanie, comes up with a new idea every day: what about green screen? VR? Resin art or 3D printers? Mel's tech brain brings such a different kind of creativity to our team. **We will offer a diverse and innovative program, guided by the passions, curiosities and needs of children.**

Our venue technician, Alex, is working to maintain our beautiful home, The Renmark Institute, and make it a more functional space for our community to use. We are passionate about facilitating collaboration with our local community and champion regional arts and towns.

If it is local, if it is joyful, if it is creative, if it empowers our community and makes the world less lonely and more accessible, we love it.

So welcome to 2023. Keep telling us what you want, need and love and we'll keep making good things happen. Thank you for trusting us with your kids and helping us keep the Riverland accessible, fun and creative.

WHO WE ARE, TODAY

For 37 years Riverland Youth Theatre has been making art with and for our community, empowering children and young people as artists, learners and doers. Our artistic program includes:

- Weekly classes for ages 0-26 throughout the Riverland
- Online creative classes for children who cannot access our program in person
- Professional development for artists & educators
- School holiday programs
- Special projects
- Opportunities for parents/carers to interact creatively with their children

In addition to artistic and creative opportunities, our tiny company provides well-being programs for vulnerable young people including the following:

- '3rd Place': offering times for young people and adults to come together in our space without expectations or structured lessons
- Pondi: our fortnightly Aboriginal Youth Group
- 1-2-1: mentoring, art and play for children and young people who thrive outside of group settings
- In 2023 we will also be offering Art Therapy in collaboration with Relationships Australia and our Tool Kits with Relationships Australia, Headspace Berri, Carers SA and the Suicide Prevention Network
